



CAMP Instrument Rental Agreement

By signing this form, you understand that:

- Students are encouraged to bring the instrument home and practice a minimum of one hour per week.
- Students may borrow their instrument for the length of their participation in CAMP programming (ideally through high school).
- Students do not need to return their instrument over the summer.
- Repairs and maintenance fees are covered by CAMP, provided they are not caused by unreasonable and/or continuous student negligence.
 - o If determined to be unreasonable and/or continuous, families will be asked to cover the cost of instrument repairs.

You agree to:

- **NEVER leave an instrument in the car.** Wooden instruments will break in both heat and cold weather. It is very common for people to break into cars to steal instruments. Save yourself some trouble and take it inside!
- **Keep instruments away from younger siblings.** Small children love to touch instruments, but they don't know how to handle them correctly. CAMP students are told to keep their instruments away from younger siblings.
- Leave instruments in a safe place. Don't leave instruments lying on a chair.
 For cellos, tuck in the endpin so people don't knock it over. Don't leave clarinets or flutes resting on a music stand. Don't put clarinets or trumpets upright on their bell.
- Do not try to fix an instrument yourself. Some parents, with the best of
 intentions, try to fix instruments and damage them further. We would be
 happy to show you some instrument care basics you can do at home
 during private instruction time on Saturdays!
