Concerts – CAMP students are required to attend full orchestra concerts. All the rehearsals held throughout the year lead up to one performance and it is very important that all students are present. (Similar to a basketball game, all players need to be there for the game to work.) **If students miss a performance without notice, they will be subject to expulsion from the program.

Recitals – All CAMP students are required to perform in a recital in the spring. This means they will either perform a solo piece (alone with piano) or a duet with another student. **If students miss a recital without notice, they will be subject to expulsion from the program.

Orchestra Breakdown

Sonata Orchestra – Beginning students (first and second year)

Chamber Orchestra – The largest orchestra for intermediate students

Symphony Orchestra – An audition-based orchestra for students who need an extra challenge

All students previously in Sonata Orchestra (beginning) must audition to move up to Chamber Orchestra. Students previously in Chamber Orchestra will remain in Chamber Orchestra unless they choose to audition for Symphony Orchestra and are accepted.

If students would like to audition for Symphony Orchestra, they can discuss the requirements with their private teacher. It is reserved for students with **good attendance, behavior, and who practice regularly at home**. Please note that while a student may be a good musician, they may not be admitted to Symphony Orchestra if they cannot live up to attendance and behavior standards.
